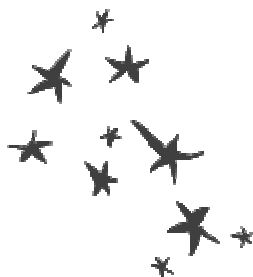

Purchasers are obligated to pay all transfer fees, license fees, and taxes as well as make arrangements for insurance coverage.

CHECK-OUT INFORMATION

If you have registered for Express Pay, all purchases will be automatically charged to your credit card, and you need not go through check out at the end of the event. Payment by all other winning bidders may be made anytime after auction check-out opens (please refer to signage or schedule). Please check out and pay for your purchase only after you are finished bidding for the evening. Payment may be made by cash, check, VISA, MasterCard, or American Express. Please make your checks payable to Martha & Mary. All invoices must be paid in full. Please take your auction purchase(s) home with you. To claim your purchases pay a cashier at the Check-Out area, then show your paid receipt to an auction official stationed near your purchase, or claim your certificate from a cashier.

BIDDER NUMBER

SILENT AUCTION

Please write your bidder number on the sheet associated with each item. If an entry is not legible, the next legible entry will be used. A bidder must meet or exceed the minimum bid and must bid by the increments noted in order to win the item. The first bidder listing their bid number in the Guaranteed Purchase Box owns that item. The "Guaranteed Purchase Box" may be signed any time before the Silent Auction closes. No bids may be made after the Silent Auction section is closed. Be careful: silent bids cannot be withdrawn; your bid number on the bid sheet constitutes a legal contract to buy. If no one has signed the "Guaranteed Purchase" Box when a section closes, the item will go to the highest bidder.

LIVE AUCTION

The live auction will be held during dinner. Please use your assigned bid number for all bids. To place a bid on a live auction item, raise your bidder number so it can be easily seen until acknowledged by the auctioneer. In accordance with the laws of the State of Washington, a bid acknowledged by the auctioneer is a legal contract to purchase the item. In the event of any questions, the auctioneer is the final decision-maker on all live auction activities.

Rev. Ingebrit Tollefson and Martha & Mary Children's Home 1891 – 1912, Lutheran Charity on the Pacific Northwest Frontier tells the story of Rev. Ingebrit Tollefson and the founding Martha & Mary Children's Home.

This history of the early days of Martha & Mary, a non-profit child and senior care provider operating throughout the Greater Kitsap region, is written by Robert L. "Bob" Nichols, a Martha & Mary trustee and local historian. The book's release coincides with festivities surrounding Martha & Mary's 125th anniversary year in 2016.

Mr. Nichols' book specifically chronicles the role Norwegian Lutheran Church leaders in late 19th century Poulsbo played in meeting the urgent care needs of children in the region. As they fulfilled their vision of a living Christianity, they also responded to their community's urgent care needs. In founding Martha & Mary, they helped to lay the foundation for social service programs that emerged in the decades that followed.

Bob Nichols is a native of Poulsbo and retired professor of Russian History and Eastern Orthodox Christianity at St. Olaf College,

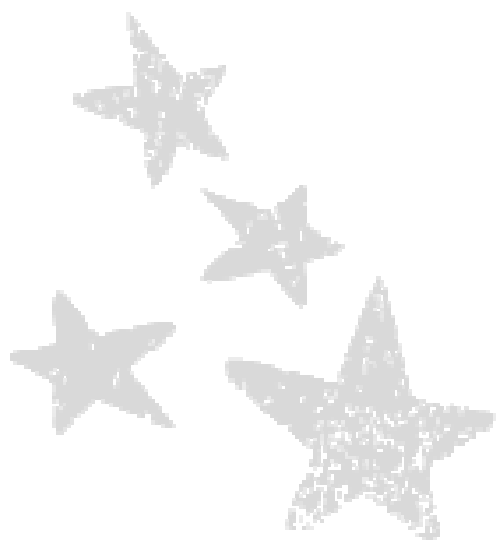
