COVID-19, the illness resulting from the novel coronavirus, has been identified at Martha & Mary Health Services in Poulsbo, Washington. “The 12 individuals diagnosed with COVID-19, which includes 7 residents and 5 employees, have been quarantined as recommended by the Kitsap Public Health District or discharged to a COVID-19 specialty facility.

We are working closely with the Kitsap Public Health District and are following procedures recommended by the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention, as required to ensure we are meeting the recommended requirements for COVID-19 testing and management and adhering to infection control practices throughout our building. We have notified all of our residents, their responsible parties and our dedicated staff of our situation. We would like the community to be aware of our status and reassure everyone that we are doing our best during these unprecedented times.”
