HEALTH SERVICES COVID-19 STATUS REPORT

It is important to us that the community have the most current and accurate information regarding our COVID-19 status. Please note, for privacy reasons, information offered is limited.

In the past three weeks, three employees in the Health Services building have tested positive for COVID-19.

We are currently testing Health Services staff twice weekly and residents once weekly.

No residents have tested positive for COVID-19 during this time.

We anticipate reducing the frequency of COVID-19 testing next week, as we are optimistic no additional cases of COVID-19 will be identified. If additional cases are diagnosed, we will continue to test until we are clear from any positive cases of COVID-19 for 14 days.

Outside of Hospice or Compassionate Care visits, general visitation has been suspended. We are hopeful to resume scheduled visits September 20, 2021.

We are also working with our staff to ensure we are in compliance with the Governors recent Proclamation mandate requiring all staff of a senior care facility be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 by October 18, 2021. We are reviewing and accepting from staff, as appropriate, requests for medical accommodations or for those with sincerely held religious beliefs, practices or observances.

Currently, our Health Services employee COVID-19 vaccination rate is 90%. COVID-19 vaccinations must be completed or religious or medical exemption must be granted prior to commencing employment at Martha & Mary.

Protecting our Martha & Mary family is paramount in all that we do. We encourage the community to wear face masks, socially distance when able, wash/sanitize your hands, avoid large gatherings and get vaccinated for COVID-19 if it is appropriate for you.
