

Martha & Mary Health Services

The end of the Public Health Emergency effective May 11, 2023, has allowed long-term care facilities to adapt to less stringent COVID precautions. These changes involve, but are not limited to, when COVID testing may be performed, when and what type of face masks are utilized and when eye protection may be necessary. To help mitigate our decisions and preventative measures, Martha & Mary Health Services now determines when to use face masks by the Community COVID Levels reported by the Department of Health. Additionally, we maintain discretion to implement COVID precautions at any time regardless of Community Levels as well as seek consultation and guidance from the Department of Health as necessary.

Health Services Guest information:

Guests are encouraged to postpone non-urgent in-person visits in the following circumstances:

- If they experienced recent exposure to a COVID positive person(s) in the past 10 days.
- If they have tested positive for COVID within the past 10 days.
- If they are experiencing any COVID symptoms and have not ruled out or tested for COVID-19.

Recommended COVID testing includes 2 rapid tests (i.e. home tests) 48 hours apart or one PCR/lab test.

If the visit can not be postponed, a medical grade face mask is required.

It is recommended that all unvaccinated guests wear a mask during their indoor visit.

Protecting the health and well-being of everyone, as we are able, is paramount in these decisions.
