## NURSING ASSISTANT SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM

At the beginning of 2024, we began a partnership with our local community college to sponsor students who desire to become Certified Nursing Assistants. In short, we offer nursing assistant training students/employees a paid position with Martha & Mary as the student/employee attends the college nursing assistant training program while working with us—paid training!

Below is a brief overview of how the sponsorship opportunity works.

1. Apply and get hired for a ***Sponsored Nursing Assistant Trainee*** position with Martha & Mary.
2. We will help you coordinate with the college to complete the nursing assistant training application and related paperwork.
3. Work at Martha & Mary in Poulsbo full time (30+ hours/week, including college class time) while you attend college training (typically 2 days per week for 12 weeks). You will initially be trained on our campus as a Hospitality Aide. After you begin your nursing assistant training through the college program, and you learn nursing assistant skills, your opportunities to use those new skills on our campus are recognized as part of your clinical training.
4. Be paid by Martha & Mary for your time with us and while attending your college class!
5. After class completion...GRADUATE! GET CERTIFIED! And...EARN MORE MONEY WITH US as you continue as an employee with Martha & Mary.

***Sponsorship opportunities are limited. Four college classes are offered per year.

*Sponsored students begin with Martha & Mary as Hospitality Aides while they wait for the nursing assistant training to begin. Through this transition, they become a Washington State Registered Nursing Assistant then Certified with successful completion of the Washington State exam.*
